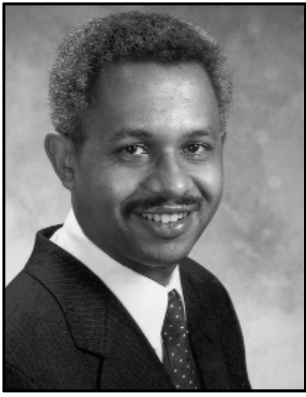

TRAINING. Dr. Harris received a Bachelor Degree from Amherst College and a Medical Degree from John Hopkins Medical School. He then completed a medical internship at Hahnemann University and a residency in ophthalmology at the Medical College of Virginia. He is a fellow at the American Academy of Ophthalmology, Philadelphia College of Physicians.

LASIK EXPERIENCE: Dr. Walter P. Harris is a surgeon at the TLC Laser Eye Center located in Plymouth Meeting, Pennsylvania, and has been performing refractive surgery since 1996. He has been extensively trained to use the excimer laser to correct myopia, hyperopia and astigmatism. He is a board Certified ophthalmologist who has been practicing over a decade. Dr. Harris is an Associate Surgeon at Wills Eye Hospital, and an Assistant Clinical Professor of Ophthalmology at Hahnemann University Medical Center Department of Surgery and Ophthalmology.
