While serving nine years in the U.S. Navy, Dr. Kontos completed his residency in flight surgery and ophthalmology. He continued his education with a Flight Surgery Degree at the Naval Aerospace Medical Institute. Before leaving the military, Dr. Kontos was on staff at Naval Hospital Portsmouth. He was one of four ophthalmologists providing comprehensive eye care to the country.
